Report on “Highlights of Union Budget-2022: Impact on Start-ups”

Participants: 176 students

Objective: To make the participants understand the Union Budget 2022 and how it will impact the start-up and also what will be Budget’s implication on the different levels of society.

Summary of the event:

Dr. D. Y. Patil Institute of Management and Research (DYPIMR) organized one day Guest Session on “Highlights of Union Budget-2022” for the students of MBA and MBA- Digital Marketing and the speaker of the session was CA Ashok Bhansali, Director in Nine Dots Management Solutions and Visiting faculty in finance in leading business schools. The session started with the introduction of DYPIMR and the Meghona Phileas, Director of DYPIMR

The session was arranged for MBA students to make and aware them about budget understanding. In order to guide students towards the importance of budget, firstly he introduced various financial and monetary terms related to budget. He very well explained the meaning of Goals of Amrit Kaal, which focuses on growth and welfare of the society and told the concept of four pillars of future. Ashok Sir discussed about the mechanism of PM Gati Shakti and inclusive developments of society. He emphasized how budget is helpful for increasing the importance of digital banking and digital payments and can be beneficial to the common man.

Tax incentives for **startups** increased from three years to four years of incorporation, in view of the pandemic, the finance minister announced in Union Budget 2022. The key benefits for startups offered redemption of taxes for three years consecutively have been extended until March 31, 2022. Sir also added Virtual Digital Asset concept to student's knowledge and highlighted the concept of capital markets, NPS, Digital rupee or currency etc to make them aware about the implications of union budget.

Mr. Ashok Bhansali presented the highlights of Union Budget 2022 and helped students to understand how budget is going to affect the different levels of society. He also explained which sectors are most influenced by the current budget and what changes can be there in Indian Economy. He concluded that budget is very good for the overall benefit of society and covering all the segments and sectors.

The session ended with the Q&A segment, in which the students asked various questions related to crypto currency, need of digital rupee, implications of digital currency on economic budget, etc. Mr. Ashok Bhansali clarified all the doubts of students and answered all the questions in a satisfied manner. The session was very informative and students got benefit of it.




