Details about Event	<p>A discussion on "How to plan for start-up and legal & ethical steps" was organised by DYPIMR. The purpose of this session is to teach the business the proper legal and ethical procedures to follow. Mr. Aditya Deshpande used a mythological tale as the basis for this session's illustration. A business idea, according to him, "is like a coffee mug filled to the brim." When an investor makes a proposal, he highlighted how various back-end procedures are carried out, including forming a business or registering a corporation, dividing the company by founder and co-founder, and many more. It defines the sorts of business structures using several examples, including sole proprietorship, general, limited liability partnership, private limited company, and non-profit corporation, and clarifies the team of co-founders, investors, incubators, and promoters. He spoke about the the various fees that must be paid when registering a company. He exemplified how we could create more intellectual property while developing a business idea and guarding it. He mentioned how we could have a "Right Legal Counsel Matter" when we are in trouble as business owners. He also discusses the various types of deposits, loan moratorium periods, intellectual property rights for animals, licensing, permit issues, and how terms differ from country to country. He talked about how there can be issues with data protection, privacy, advertising and</p>

	marketing, and various contracts. He finally concluded the session by discussing Tortious Liabilities, Ethical Liabilities, and many more issues that may arise due to counterfeiting our products and issues with labor laws. The questions written by the participants were cleared out by the end of the session

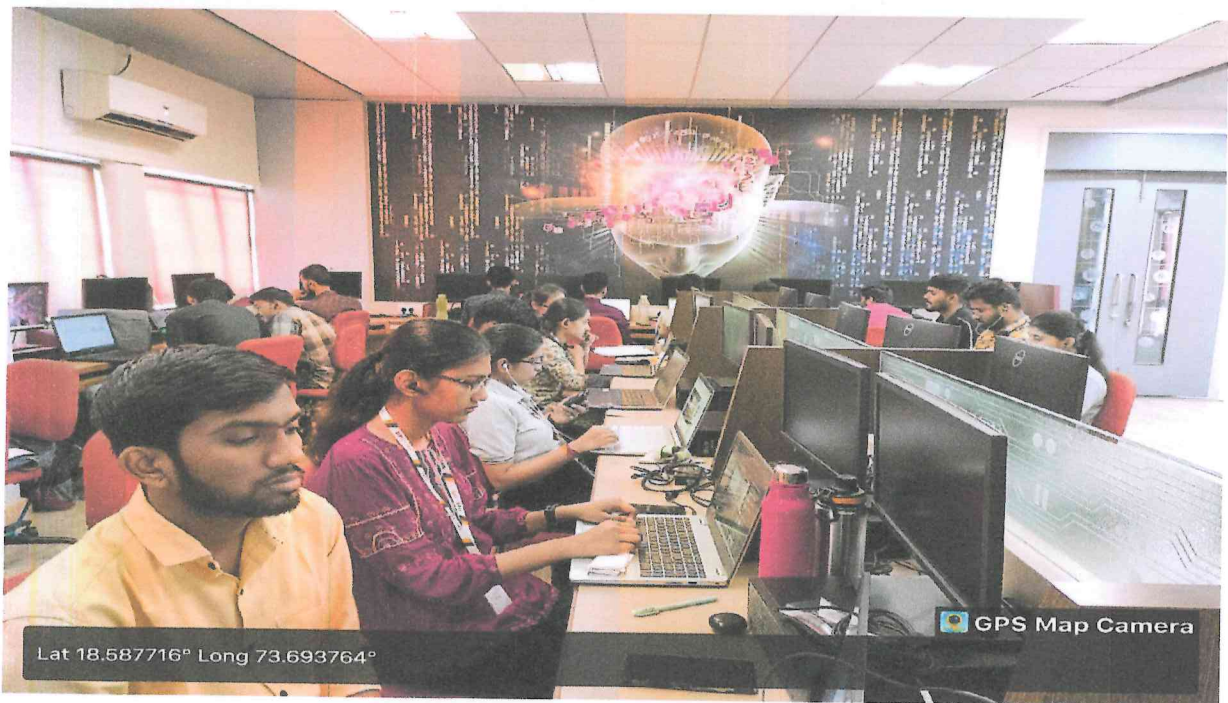


